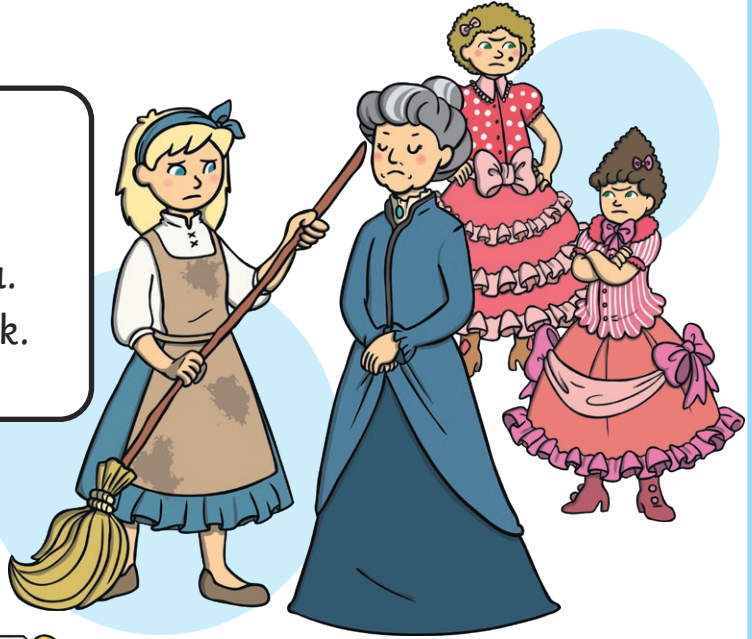


Cinderella

"I want to go to the ball," said Cinderella.

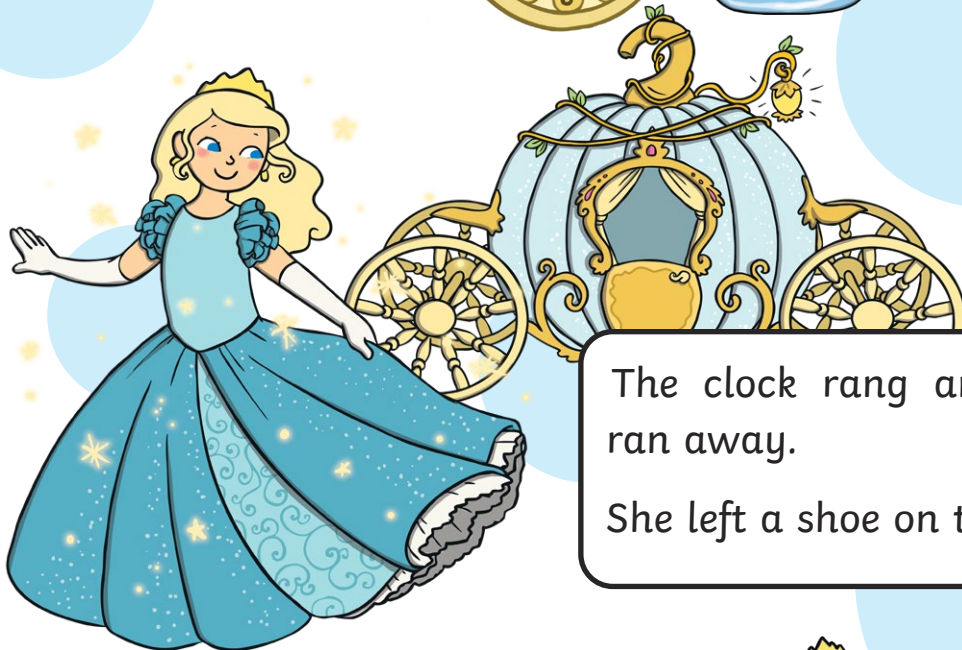
The fairy godmother came.

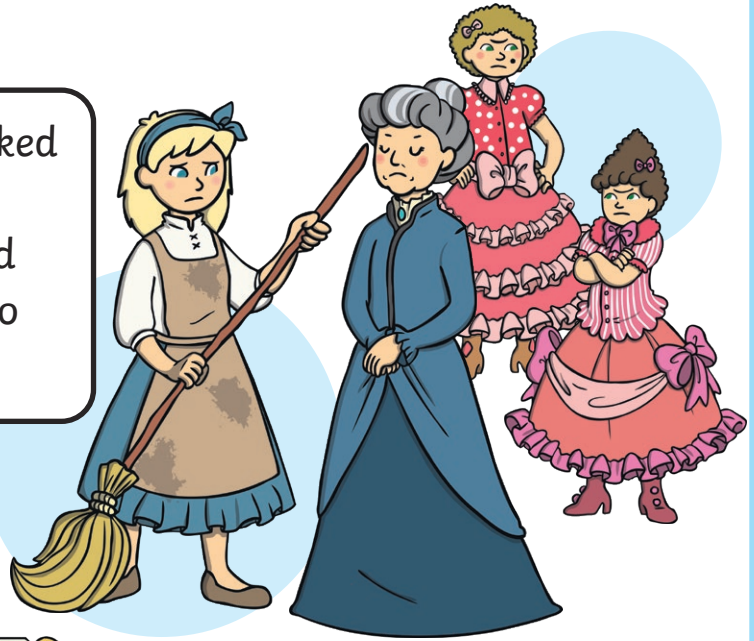

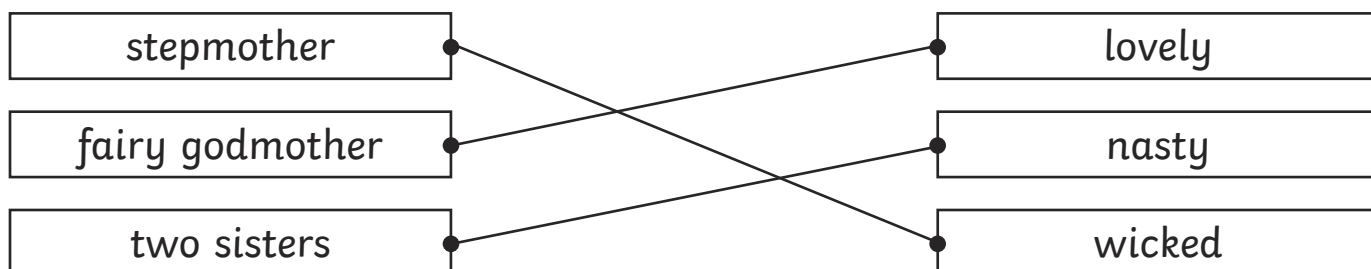

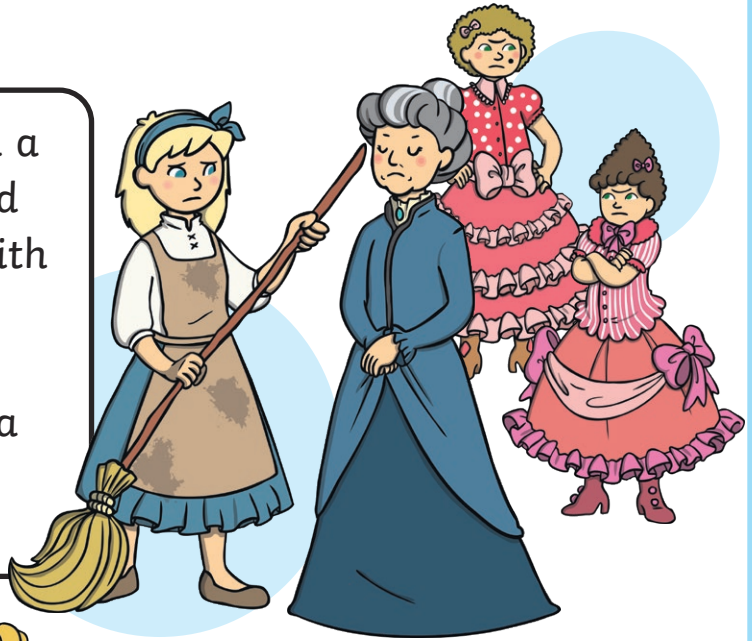
